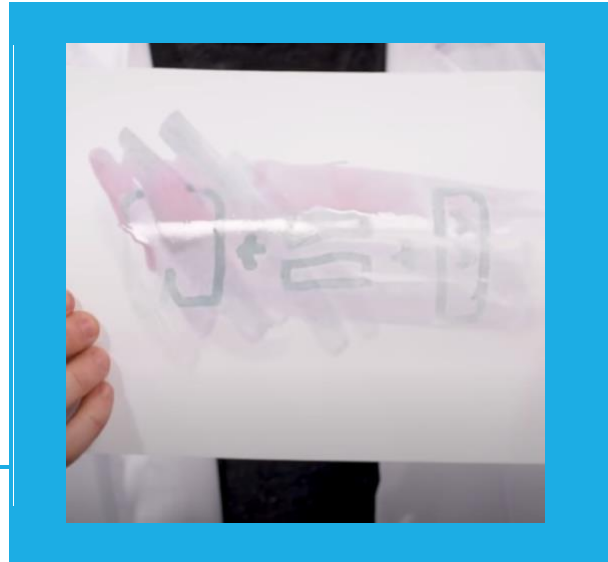




### HAHN'S INVISIBLE INK EXPERIMENT

In this activity, your child will do their very own invisible ink experiment, just like the one from Hahn's lab. It will remind them that even though we can't see the Holy Spirit, he is always with us. Have fun and remember to keep a careful eye on your child and the experiment at all times.



### DIRECTIONS

1. Measure:
  - ¼ cup baking soda
  - ¼ cup of water
  - ¼ cup of grape juice
2. Gather two paint brushes, two cups, and paper.
3. Mix the baking soda and water in one cup.
4. Fill ¼ cup grape juice in a second cup.
5. Use a paintbrush to write a secret message on the piece of paper with the baking soda and water solution. *Optional: Write a message that ties into the lesson like Holy Spirit or Acts 1:8*
6. Let the paper dry completely.
7. Dip another paintbrush into the grape juice and use it to paint over the paper, revealing the message underneath.

### SUPPLIES NEEDED



Heavy paper or cardstock



2 Cups



2 Paint brushes



¼ Cup baking soda



¼ Cup water



¼ Cup grape juice
