

GOD'S GOOD PLANS

ACTIVITY | LESSON 2

PAINTING WITH NATURE

In this activity, your child will make their own piece of art that will remind them that God is always with them, even if they feel alone. Using things they find in God's creation, this activity allows your child to get creative to make something that helps them think about God and his good plans.

DIRECTIONS

- 1. Get your child ready to go on a walk with you.
- 2. Tell them that while you walk you are going to look at all the beautiful and different kinds of plants God made.
- 3. Together you will collect sticks, leaves, flowers, or whatever other textured items you can find outside.
- 4. Using rubber bands, attach each different item (flower, leaves, bushes, etc.) to the end of a stick, making unique and different paint brushes.
- 5. Give your child some paint and paper and ask them to paint something that reminds them of God.
- 6. Once it is finished, your child can hang it up in their room to remind them that God is always with them.
