# The Big Idea

Living for our own sense of comfort and luxury keeps us static, but living for God -a life that gives God glory -moves us forward. From the moment that Paul gave over his life to Jesus Christ, he experienced...and embraced...the very trouble and persecution that he himself had been doling out to the believers. What we learn from Paul and the Scriptures is that following Jesus includes suffering. Giving God glory is what drove Paul to Rome; it's what propelled him forward in the purposes of God.

# Where we are in the Bible

Acts 28:1-6. One night in prison, Paul receives this message from God: "Keep up your courage! For just as you have testified for me in Jerusalem, so you must bear witness also in Rome." On the way, they became shipwrecked on the island of Malta and were forced to receive the hospitality of the natives, and as Paul is placing driftwood on the campfire a viper jumps out and bites his hand. As the natives see this, they begin to guess what kind of prisoner Paul is since death has appeared to catch up with him despite surviving the shipwreck. These are superstitious people, so when time goes by without any detection of poison from the snake bite, "they changed their minds and began to say that he was a god." It *could* be a nice place to stay and live comfortably, but Paul remained faithful to his call.
